



DECLARATION OEKO-TEX® certified factory

Dear Sir, Madam,

We do hereby declare that our item number MT4003 (beach towel) is produced in an OEKO-TEX® certified factory.

The factory is granted authorisation according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark, for the following articles:

Towel, bathrobe and wash gloves made of 100% cotton, 100% viscose from bamboo fibre, cotton/viscose from bamboo fibre, cotton/polyester, cotton/polyester/viscose (all incl. polyester or recycled polyester staple fiber, raw white or dope-dyed in a limited range of 3 pigments and carbon black) and cotton/viscose from bamboo fibre/viscose (all incl. TURALEAR®, dope-dyed fiber) woven towel fabrics, bleached, piece- or yarndyed (with reactive dyestuffs), reactive printed and finished, with or without water alkali-solube cotton and alkali-solube cotton finished, incl. acc. (PES sewing and embroidery thread, embroidery paper backing, PES woven label, and PES, PA, CO, CO/PES, PES/CO printed labels, PET film metallic yarn, entwined with PES or PA yarn) (based on material partly pre-certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®)

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 6, product class I have shown that the above-mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKOTEX® presently established in Annex 6 for products for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; except for accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified). The conformity is verified by audits.

The certificate is valid until **15.07.2021**.
